ABOUT

The CGSD is a federal program of scholarships awarded through national competitions by the granting tri-council agencies: the Canadian Institutes of Health Research (CIHR), the Natural Sciences and Engineering Research Council of Canada (NSERC) and the Social Sciences and Humanities Research Council of Canada (SSHRC).

Note: In addition to the CGS D, each agency has its own doctoral awards. Refer to the appropriate literature for [CIHR](#), [NSERC](#) and [SSHRC](#) for further details. Meritorious CGS D applicants may also be eligible for agency-specific doctoral awards. Applicants complete and submit one application to be considered for both a CGS D scholarship and an agency-specific doctoral award (exception: [CIHR DFSA](#)). CGS D scholarships are offered to top-ranked eligible applicants. Some eligibility requirements for CGS D differ from those of the [agency-specific doctoral awards](#).

ELIGIBILITY | full details – [link](#) (see “eligibility”)

To be eligible to apply, an applicant must:

- be enrolled in a [program of study](#) that includes a significant research component.
- be a Canadian citizen or a permanent resident of Canada, as of the application deadline date;
- have completed no more than **24 months** of full-time study in their doctoral program by December 31, 2023 if previously enrolled in a graduate program;
- have completed no more than **36 months** of full-time study in their doctoral program by December 31, 2023 if enrolled directly from a bachelor’s to a PhD program (with no time spent in a master’s program);
 - direct-entry applicants must be enrolled in their doctoral program at the time of application.
- submit only one doctoral award application in a given academic year. Nominations to the [Vanier CGS](#) program **do not count** towards this limit;
- not have already received a doctoral-level scholarship or fellowship from CIHR, NSERC or SSHRC.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Applicants applying through UBC will either be:

- currently registered in, or are on an approved leave of absence from, a degree program at UBC;
- not currently registered in but previously held active registration in a UBC degree program (any academic term) during the calendar year of application (Jan 1 - Dec 31, 2023).

Please confirm your intention to apply (**no later than Fri Sep 1, 2023**). Transcripts are the **applicant’s responsibility** and we do not guarantee that all necessary documents will be on file.

UBC Affiliated Fellowships: Doctoral-level Funding

About

The UBC Affiliated Fellowships doctoral competition runs in concert with the university-adjudicated Tri-Agency Canada Graduate Scholarships-Doctoral (CGS-D) competition. Students who submit an NSERC, SSHRC, or CIHR doctoral award application are eligible for “unrestricted” Affiliated Fellowships and **do not** need to submit a separate Affiliated Fellowships application. To be considered for “criteria-based” affiliated fellowship(s), students must submit [this checklist](#) to their graduate program by the application deadline.

ELIGIBILITY

- Awards are made on the basis of academic excellence *regardless of citizenship or visa status*.
- Canadian citizens and permanent residents **are required to apply** to the [Tri-Agency CGSD program](#), if they are eligible to do so.
